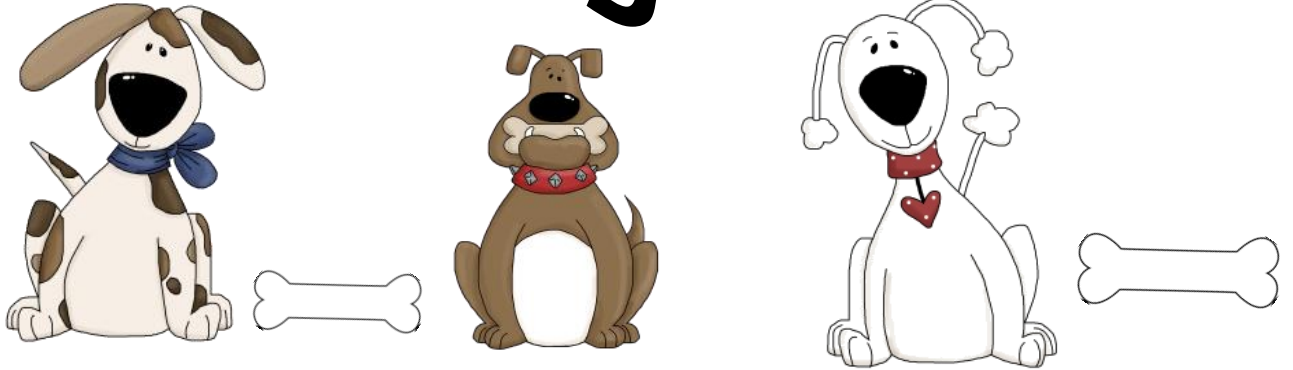

Singular Possessive

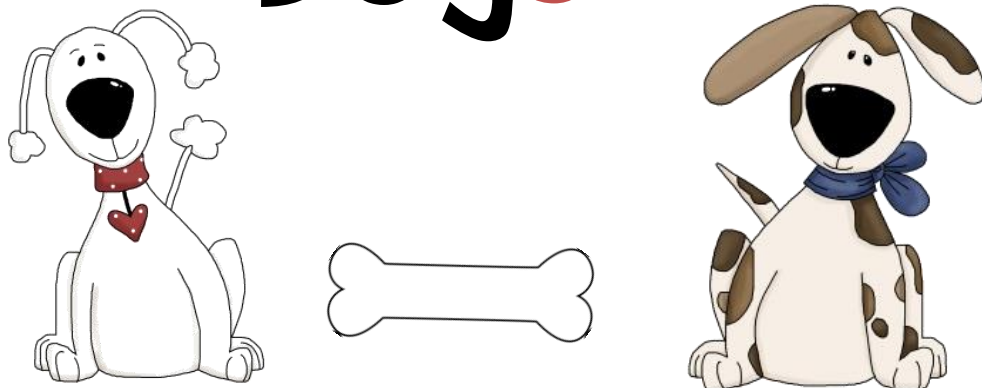
Dog's
